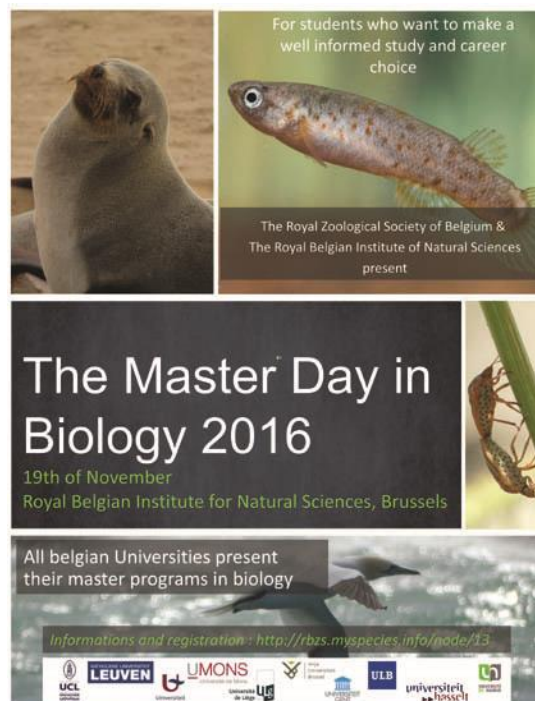


Interuniversity Master Information Day BIOLOGY
